Living Lanterns

Public art installation, Yahara Riverway, Madison, WI. The City of Madison Arts Commission, Blink Grant, September - November 2008

- Sculpture installation: Using fabric, bamboo, rope, photovoltaic solar lighting. 15 lanterns, 8-15in, hang in a stand of trees, like cocoons, then cascade down across the river, glowing alive at night.

Stone Works:

Earth Pinnacle

Stacked, found, stones, Isthmus, Madison Wisconsin, 2005

- Reclaimed stones are stacked to create a stone pinnacle, to honor the earth. This piece has been recycled into new sculptures and creations.

Life Pinnacle

Stacked stones, Isthmus, Madison, Wisconsin, 2005

- Stones are stacked to create a stone pinnacle, to honor those who were before us.

Homage

Stacked river stone and branches, Turkey River, Elkport Iowa, 2005

- Gathered stones from the rivers edge are stacked to create a hollow vessel of stone in the middle of the river, paying homage to the river. As rivers run strong, all of the materials have been re-deposited down stream and this piece exists only as a photograph.
